- Treasurer's report
  - Beginning balance \$38,090.77.
  - Paid out \$6,391.79 (\$5k for spirit wear), deposits of \$1,266.59
  - Ending balance \$32,965.57.
  - Fun run expenses totaled \$4,573.28. Total deposits \$22,695.44. Total profit \$18,122.16.
- Alex spoke about PTC funding 5<sup>th</sup> grade celebration
  - Asked PTC to fund tie die shirts totaling around \$921, CD's \$38 and classroom party around \$20.00
  - Alex to check what's in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade fund and circle back to PTC by March to see what is needed.
- Movie Day
  - President's Day Feb 18 2019 and movie is House with a Clock in its Walls
  - Tickets will be sent home with report cards. Three shows – 9am Theater 2 (120 seats), 10am Theater 4 (170 seats) and 11am Theater 1 (120 seats).
  - Sign up for ticket sales week before show and ticket collections day of movie.
- Paint Night
  - 41 tickets have been sold
  - Drew to see if custodian will set up tables.
- Brain Pop
  - All teachers use this software.
  - Cost is \$2,550 for annual subscription. PTC voted yes to pay for it.

  - Abby to head up silent auction. Needs volunteer to pick up items in Bend.

  - DJ and Photo booth will use same people as last year.

  - Crystal will handle all the food and drinks. This is a one off time that she will have EGMS Spanish club work the food.
    - Crystal to pick up pizzas, water, corn dogs and chips from Costco. Spanish club will sell items and keep the profits for their trip overseas.
  - Megan to call on two food carts – Kettle corn and shaved ice. Put contract in place.
